GOLF DAY TERMS & CONDITIONS and INFORMATION

Reading Golf Club celebrated its Centenary in 2010 and is situated at Emmer Green to the north of Reading. Originally known as “The Caversham and South Oxon Golf Club”, the course was designed by five times Open Champion, James Braid. Set amongst the rolling wooded slopes of the southern Chilterns, the course offers a challenging test to golfers of all abilities. Accuracy from both tee and fairway will be required if a good score is to be achieved. Irrigation to tees, greens and some fairways, keeps the course in tip-top condition all year round, with the speed and trueness of the greens being testimony to the skills of the green keeping staff. The course measures 6088 yards from the Yellow tees and has a Par of 70.

Bookings:

Societies and Company Golf events are welcomed on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays and on Fridays by special arrangement with the Secretary. A non-refundable deposit should accompany the booking form and will act as final confirmation of your booking.

Final numbers should be advised **no later than 48 hours** before the day of your visit. The numbers advised at this time will be the minimum number to be charged. Please note the minimum number of players is 8, with a maximum of 60 unless special arrangements have been made.

On the Day:

The Organiser is responsible for ensuring all players adhere to Golf Rules and Etiquette. Play will be from Yellow Tees (Ladies play from Red Tees).

All players are required to observe the Club’s Dress Code. An explanatory sheet is enclosed. Please ensure all players are aware of the regulations. We do not consider them to be restrictive – merely those necessary to maintain a proper standard.

The use of Mobile Phones is restricted to the Clubhouse Lobby and Car Park areas.

The Organiser is responsible for settling the account prior to departure from the Club unless previously arranged otherwise.

Liability:

Reading Golf Club accepts no liability for any injury, loss or damage to persons or their property whilst on the Course, in the Clubhouse or other areas of the grounds or Car Park. Liability insurance is now provided for all players within the green fee charge.

Reading Golf Club Dress Code

We wish to convey a modern approach to dress regulations to ensure that standards are maintained and that playing golf and relaxing in the Clubhouse afterwards is an enjoyable experience for all members, guests and visitors. Your adherence to the dress code will be appreciated.

On the Golf Course and Putting Green the following is acceptable



- Conventional golf clothing
- Shirts with collars or round/crew neck golf shirts
- Shorts and Skirts, which must be of a respectable length, tailored and worn with white visible sports socks or knee length socks.
- Golf shirts must be worn inside the waistband
- at all times. Players may however wear tops outside their trousers or skirts when they are so designed.
- Peaked hats or caps may only be worn with the peak to the front, and must be removed before entering the Clubhouse.

The following are therefore unacceptable

- Denim jeans, or track suit bottoms.
- Non-tailored shorts.
- Collarless and or sleeveless shirts, rugby or football style shirts or jerseys.
- Shirts or outer garments with prominent logos or numbers.
- Trousers tucked into socks, other than plus twos or plus fours.
- Trainers or other non-golfing footwear.

Players are reminded that those found to be not suitably attired will be asked to change or leave the course and that changing in the car park is not permitted.

In the Clubhouse and on the Deck

Smart casual dress may be worn throughout the Clubhouse unless otherwise stated for a particular social event or function.

Denim jeans, track suits, tee shirts, singlet's, trainers and flip flops should not be worn at any time.

Golf hats, golf shoes and wet weather clothing must not be worn in the lounge/dining areas.
